ASSEMBLY RECOMMENDATIONS

You can use screws or tightening knobs to fasten the different components.

For parts assembly, we recommend the use of a wrench which allow you to control the tension more easily.

When tightening the different components, on a scale of 0 to 10, it is preferable to have a tension of 6. This will make it easier for you to make adjustments throughout the installation.

Secure a male and female attachments with tension 4 on the kickstand side, allowing them to slide along the seatstays. Next, attach ½ tightening knob and tighten the clamp with tension 9.

Secure a male and female attachments with tension 4 on the chain side of the bike in line with the clamp attached in the previous step on the kickstand side. (Figure 3A & 3B)

Slide the clamp so that the vertical stem of the rack mounting branch is perpendicular to the ground and slightly in front of the bike's rear axle. Tighten securely (tension 10) to the seatstays.

Once the clamp on the kickstand side is securely fastened to the tension 10, remove the rack mounting branch.

Attach the two rack mounting branches to the BYCIGOLF rear rack with the four ½ screws.

Figure 6Attach the square tube connector to the saddle post clamps.

Insert the square tube connector into the BYCIGOLF rear rack.

Making sure the rack is level with the ground, stretch the tube connector to the saddle post.

Next, place the clamps around the saddle post and tighten the knob of the BYCIGOLF rear rack where the connector is inserted, then to the saddle post clamps.

An alternative to the previous step is to remove the saddle. This method can make it easier to attach clamps to the saddle post.

Insert the BYCIGOLF cart hitch into the appropriate hole in the BYCIGOLF rear rack.

Then tighten the knob until the cart hitch stops moving.
